Wellington Middle-High School (WMHS) is a comprehensive four year public high school (grades 9-12) located in Wellington, Colorado. Wellington has a population of around 12,000 and is close to Colorado State University and many tech and agricultural industries. WMHS is part of Poudre School District (PSD), which has a total enrollment of 30,463 students with a professional staff of 2,036. WMHS is on a 4x4 Block Schedule. Each 9-week course meets daily for 90 minutes and is worth 5 credits. **2025 will be WMHS's first full graduating class of Seniors.**

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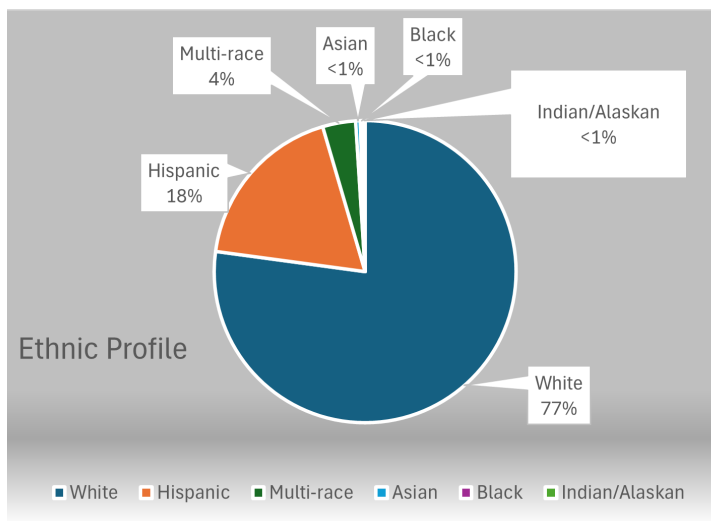

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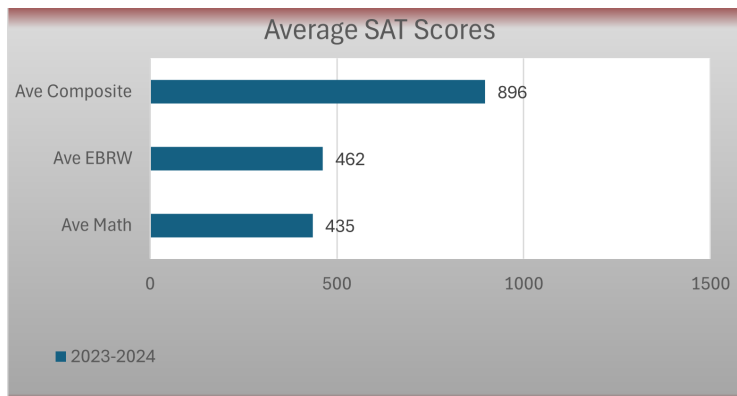

Unweighted Cumulative	Students GPAs are calculated on the 4 point scale regardless of whether or not the course is an AP or post-secondary course.
Adjusted	Students earn GPA bonus points of .002 for each credit earned in AP/post-secondary/concurrent enrollment courses in which students receive an A, B, or C grade.
Weighted Cumulative	Students earn GPA bonus points of 1.0 for each credit earned in AP/post-secondary/concurrent enrollment courses in which students receive an A, B, or C grade.

CLASS RANK

Class rank is calculated based on a student's adjusted GPA.

- Top 10% GPA = 4.080-3.904
- Top 20% GPA = 3.886-3.227
- Top 50% GPA = 3.196-2.848

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Special Considerations: Wellington Middle High School was built in 2021, and the school opened for its first year in 2022 serving grades 6 - 10. In that opening year, tenth grade students all transferred from other high schools in the area. Because of this transition, some course sequences were not offered, and some students were not able to access previous course sequences at the new building due to the smaller size of the class of 2025, staffing, and differing programs. These interruptions were of no fault of the individual student, but a product of this transition. This important context will be reflected on student transcripts.
