



CLASSES TAKEN ON THE COLLEGE CAMPUS

Once students have taken a college-level course at their home high school or the PSD Career Tech Center (CTC), they may be <u>eligible</u> to enroll in classes at Aims or FRCC on the college campus or online. PSD pays for students' tuition, books and fees (not supplies)

PROCESS

How do students apply to take a class?

- Step #1 Review <u>eligibility guidelines</u>
- Step #2 Meet with your counselor
- Step #3 Determine the courses you want to take
- Step #4 Complete the <u>PSD Campus</u> <u>Select Application</u>
- Step #5 Complete the FRCC or Aims Admissions Application
- Step #6 Complete the online orientation (if new to FRCC campus select)
- Step #7 Register for classes
- Step #8 Complete PSD's CE Agreement Form each semester

COURSES

What courses do I want?

APPLICATION

What is the application timeline?

The application deadline for **Fall 2025** is <u>May 28, 2025</u>.

CREDITS

How many credits am I allowed to take?

- 0 credits Freshman year
- 3 credits Sophomore year (spring semester only)
- 9 credits Junior year
- 12 credits Senior year

Certificate Programs are an exception (for example: welding, EMT, CNA)

REGISTRATION

How do students register for classes?

Students register for classes directly with the college, not with their high school counselor. FRCC has 2 enrollment advisors that come to the high schools to assist students with this.

ELIGIBILITY

If the class is offered at the high school as high school select, it cannot be taken as a campus select class.

Students must be enrolled as a full-time student in the fall for the year they want to take a campus select class.

If a student fails a class or withdraws from more than one class in a semester, they have to sit out the next semester.

Students must apply for each semester they want to participate by the deadline. *Late applications are not accepted.
